Our facility is dedicated to the rehabilitation of sea turtles and educating the public on the important ecological role of sea turtles, threats endangering them, and ways to protect their future. Prior to Sea Turtle Recovery's opening, endangered and threatened sea turtles that stranded in New Jersey due to illness or injury could be stabilized in New Jersey but, if they needed long term care, had to be transferred out of state. These sea turtles had to endure long transports as far south as North Carolina. Also, each year the increased sea turtle strandings in the Northeast Region of the United States caused several facilities to reach capacity. With this occurring, it did not leave available space for New Jersey's stranded sea turtles. Sea Turtle Recovery was created to help these turtles in need.

We appreciate that *Sponsor company* recognizes, similar to other Species360 Corporate Sponsors, that the zoological community can't allow critical wildlife husbandry and medical information to be hidden in inaccessible locations or fragmented into multiple databases – and that the information at Species360 may very well hold the key to survival of one or more species. Port Moresby Nature Park has much to offer the community and PNG as a whole.
